Introduction to Judaism I, II

This Class meets and exceeds the standards set by the Union of Reform Judaism. It is intended for those who wish to join the Jewish People, and those who want to learn about their Jewish heritage and faith.

Introduction to Judaism I covers: Life Cycles (including conversion), Minor and Major Festivals, Shabbat, and Worship.

Introduction to Judaism II covers: Theology, History, Torah and Rabbinics. (Offered in the Spring)

Both are required prior to conversion. Classes will run Monday evenings, (mostly consecutively) for 1.5 hours per evening. Registration required: Contact Temple Office to register and for book list.

- To encourage people to take an active role in Temple life and to enable them to foster Jewish life for themselves and for their families.

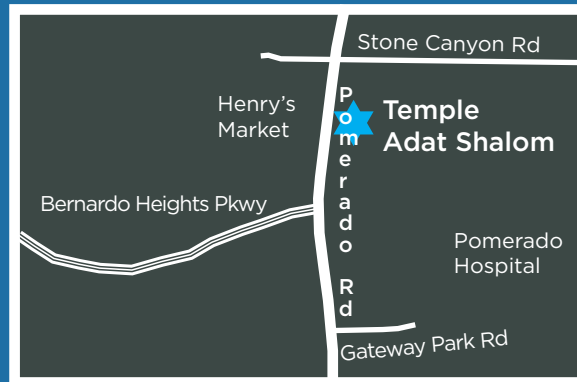
