Outreach Programs

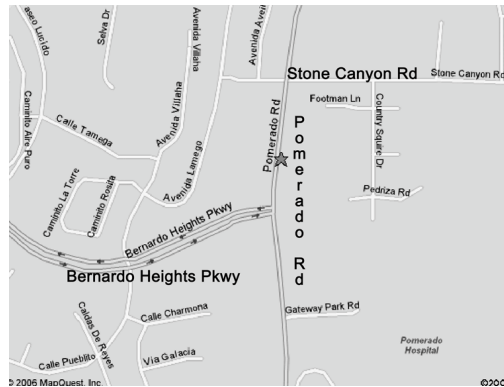
