Starting with a short history of the Yiddish language, this class will examine a wide variety of Yiddish literature in translation starting with S. Ansky's *The Dybbuk*, followed by a viewing of the film of the same name. We will then investigate a variety of short stories by Sholom Aleichem, Isaac Peretz, Mocher Sforim, *et al.* We will also read two novels, *The Slave*, by Isaac Bashevis Singer and *The Last of the Just*, by André Schwarzbart. Together, we will discuss other stories both in translation as well as attempt to read some poems in the original language. Other films to be viewed will be Molly Picon's *Mamele* and Maurice Schwartz's *Tevye*. All films will be in Yiddish with English subtitles.

This class is designed for the English speaker but is a perfect class if you are looking to reconnect with your Yiddish past or become acquainted with a rich historical culture.
